The article is an observometric study of repository software's used in India. The use of software's for the purpose of the storing digital artifacts and numbers of such digital records stored in various repositories are explored here.

The benefits of the digital technology helping in storing information in a condensed format give a continuous access to all the digital content stored in the repository. It is an Information Systems that store, manage, preserve, and provide access to digital knowledge which serves multiple purposes. Their primary goal is to support scholarly communication and provide open access to articles, dissertations, and research data in case of academic environment. Hence understanding the importance of the which is an online archive used to store digital documents which are available in various format from image, text, books, reports or manuscripts or anything in a digital form.

#### 4.1 Total Repositories Uploaded

It is seen that many organization in India are using the repository and are extensively used for storing all the digital. The Table No.1 shows maximum use organization is Sodhaganga .There are 907307 metadata records fig no.1 and two gives the numerical details of the metadata. The highest no of records (Metadata) are in Shodhaganga is 29% age of total metadata, the second is Krishikosha 19% and third is Indian Academy of Sciences publication of fellows 16%.

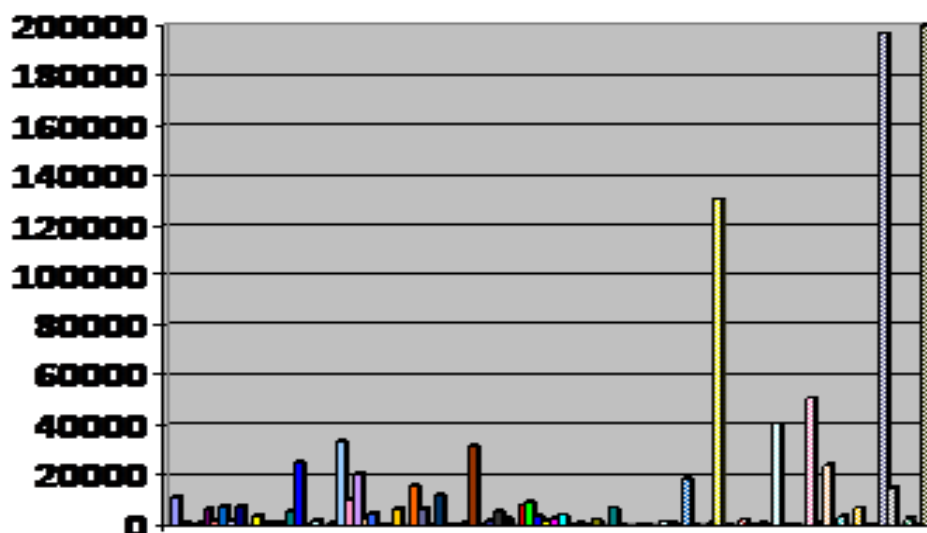


Fig No 1 Repositories in OPEN DOAR

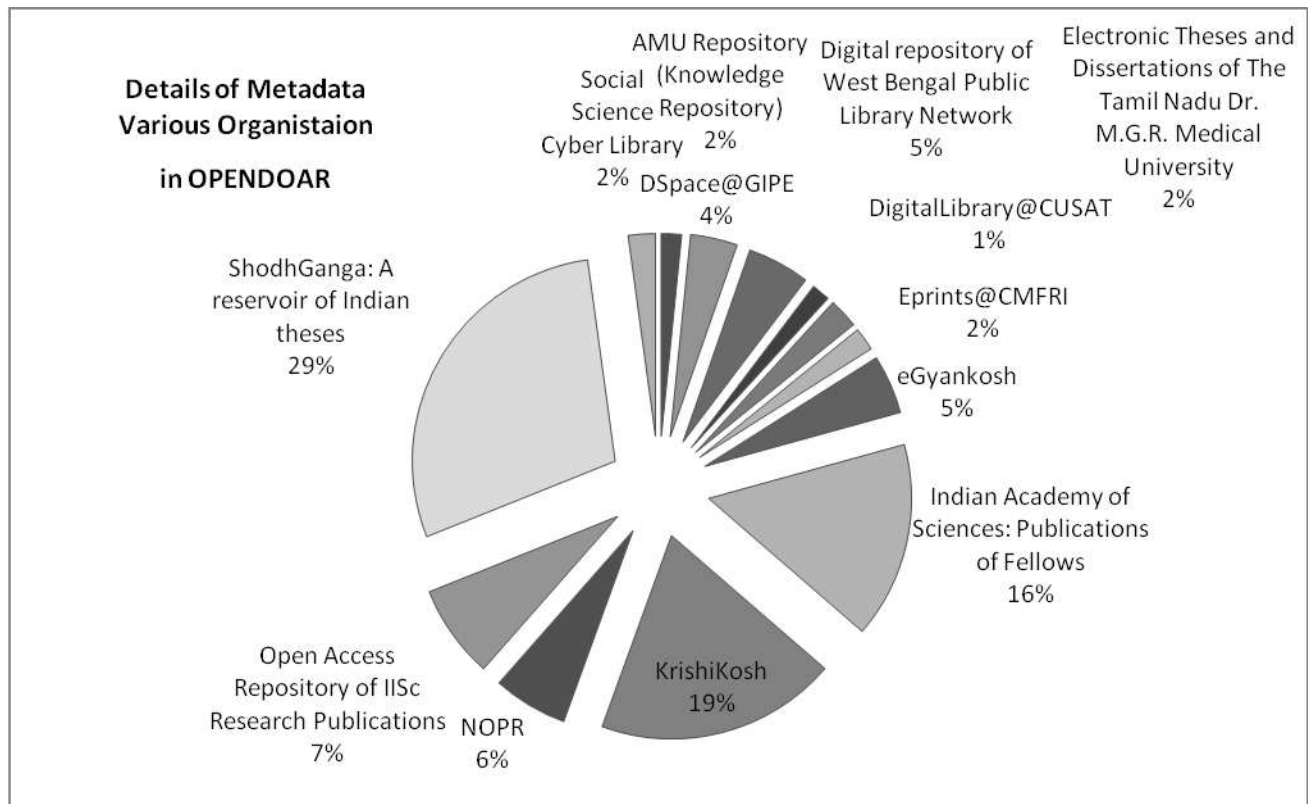


Figure No 2. %age of major metadata of Organization

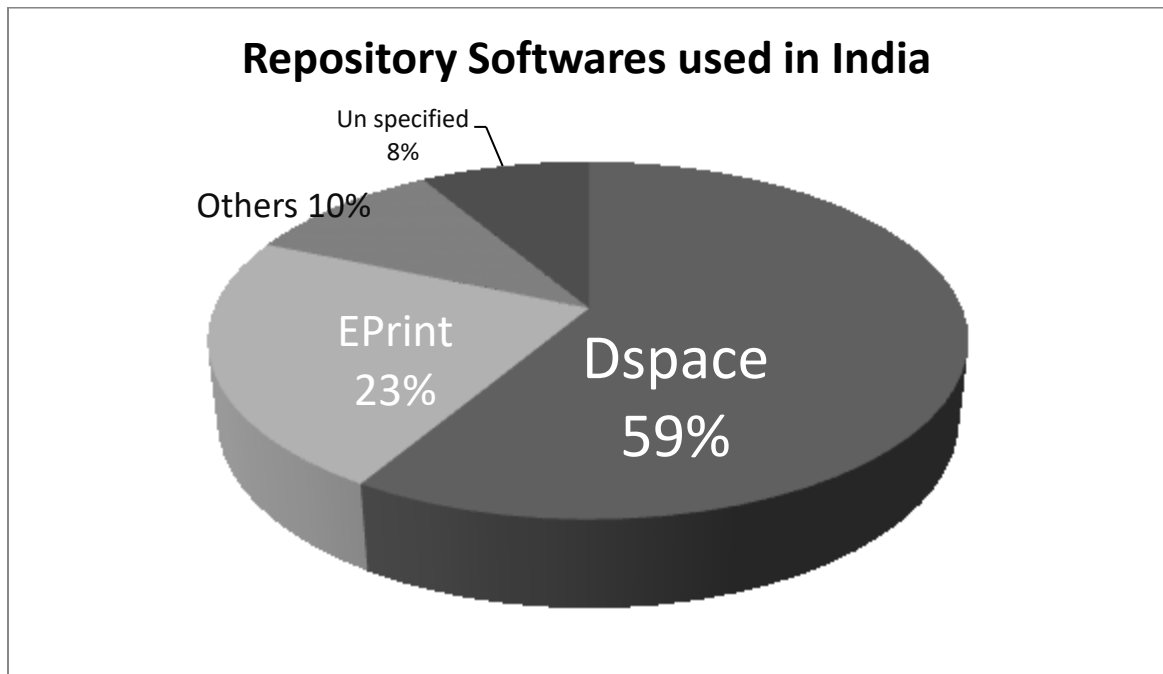


Fig No 2: Repository Software's used in India in OPEN DOAR
